BIG DOOR PRIZES TO ADD EXCITEMENT TO 2009 FARM SHOW

With the compliments of two prominent agricultural companies, this year's Ottawa Valley Farm Show will feature a pair of major door prizes as an extra incentive for visitors to attend the event at Lansdowne Park in Ottawa March 17, 18, 19.

This will mark the 82nd edition of the Farm Show sponsored by the Ottawa Valley Seed Growers Association. It's the largest agricultural trade show in Ontario east of Toronto.

Association directors finalized details for the draw at a recent meeting held in Kemptville. Despite unstable economic times, they noted that this year's Farm Show is shaping up as another jam-packed success with more than 320 exhibitors.

For one lucky ticket holder, Agtrek Nutrition will cover the cost of four nights at Mont Tremblant in a two-bedroom condo with spa across the lane, a 10-minute walk to the central ski village.

To another winner, Cover-All will provide a \$2,000 cheque towards purchase of one of its buildings, minimum size 40 x 80-ft.

People buying \$8 admission tickets on all three days of the show will be eligible. The draw will be held March 19 at about 3 pm; winners won't have to be present to claim their prizes.

"I've got to thank these two Farm Show exhibitors for their generosity," said Seed Growers director Barry Dean who organized the draw.

"It'll add another attraction to the Farm Show which has been a must-do event for several generations of rural families from across Eastern Ontario and beyond."
